



Self Interview Project

In this project you will be creating a 2-3 minute long video with you acting as both the interviewer and interviewee. This project requires considerable planning and forethought in order to make it look realistic. Be sure to use your class time well and pay attention to details.

1. Choose a career that you would like to be doing when you are 30 years old.
2. Do research to find out what requirements, training or education you need to become qualified for that profession.
3. Record research information and resources used on a word document to be turned in and graded.
4. Use your research information to create a script and storyboard that incorporates picture in a picture for a self interview. Include some stories/anecdotes/details about how you chose your profession. Be sure to think about background, costumes (for interviewer and interviewee) camera angles, and interviewer and interviewee response.
5. After planning, rehearse both parts of the script and be sure to consider “response time.”
6. Sign up for the camera equipment and shoot your video in the back of the room. Shoot all of your interview questions first, and then all of your interviewee answers/responses.
7. Import video to your computer and edit using “Picture in a Picture.”
8. Convert the movie to a Windows Media file and burn it to a CD.
9. Put your name on the CD and turn it in to the CD case.
